

#### **Organisation**

1. The Willie Loughman Memorial Forest Rally is promoted and organised by

Carrick-on-Suir Motor Club Ltd. (hereafter known as the organisers)

2. The rally is a qualifying round of the Valvoline National Forest Rally

Championship 2017, the Suirway Group South East Stages Rally Championship and the Carrick-on-Suir Motor Club Championship.

3. These regulations have been submitted and approved by Motorsport Ireland and the necessary permit for the holding of the Competition has been granted.

#### CLASSES.

The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes as necessary depending on the number of entries received.

All vehicles must be accompanied by a log book issued by Motorsport Ireland or by the MSA.

(See Appendix 32 of the 2017 Motorsport Ireland Year Book for class notes & Championship Regulations)

#### ENTRIES.

The Entry Fee is €575 plus €75 Insurance Levy and will be reduced to €550 plus €75 Insurance levy on entries received and paid by Wednesday the 1<sup>st</sup> February 2017 (This includes Motorsport Ireland, Personal Accident Insurance; Standard Rate IRDS Insurance and Fire extinguisher charge). Cheques should be made payable to: Carrick-on-Suir Motor Club Ltd.

The additional premium will be collected at documentation from any driver with Special Terms on the IRDS/BRDS database.

Proof of IRDS/BRDS cover must be available (on MI website database) at Documentation.

THE ORDNANCE SURVEY 'DISCOVERY SERIES' MAP NO. 75 WILL BE USED FOR THE EVENT, HOWEVER THE CLUB WILL HAVE AVAILABLE MARKED MAPS FOR THE EVENT IN A3 COLOUR.

#### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS.

#### Article 1

The competition will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA,
The General Competition Rule of the Motorsport Ireland, these Supplementary Regulations and the
Valvoline National Forest Rally Championship Regulations. All competitors who forward a
completed Entry Form agree to be bound by these rules.

#### Article 2

- The supplementary Regulations for the Rally are as stated by the Motorsport Ireland 2017 Yearbook and the Valvoline National Forest Rally Championship also in the 2017 Yearbook.
- 2 Final Instructions form an integral part of these Supplementary Regulations.

#### Article 3

The use of Forestry Lands for testing or practicing is prohibited, anyone found doing so on the stages to be used for this event will be refused a start and reported to Motorsport Ireland. All named officials are judges of fact, in this regard.

#### Article 4

- Safety notes will be allowed on this event. Competitors will not be allowed Recce the stages before the event.
- 2 Safety notes will be available from third parties on Saturday, 11<sup>th</sup> February 2017. The Club has no involvement in their preparation or sale and accepts no responsibility for their accuracy.

#### Article 5

10. Rally 2 (Restart after Retirement)

#### 10.1: General

- **10.1.1** The rally will operate Rally 2 in accordance with Art 13, Appendix 29 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook (as published on MI Website)
- **10.1.2** A crew retiring from the rally between Parc Ferme Out and Arrival Control SS2, may restart the rally from Service Out Control after 2 stages. A crew retiring between Arrival Control SS2 and Arrival Control SS4, may restart from Service Out Control after 4 stages. A crew retiring between Arrival Control SS4 and Arrival Control SS5, may restart from Service Out Control after 5 stages.

No restart will be permitted for crews retiring on Special Stages 5 or 6.

A restart will not be permitted where a crew has been excluded for non-compliance with eligibility requirements, traffic violations or a decision of the COC/R2C (Rally 2 Co-ordinator).

On retirement the crew must hand in their time cards to Car Accountability or the marshal/timekeeper at the next available location/Time Control.

Crews must retain the duplicate copy of the time card, to present to R2C as proof of stages completed.

- **10.1.3** Competitors must register for Rally 2 if they wish to restart from Service Out Control after 2, 4 or 5 stages by contacting the R2C prior to a time that will be specified in Final Instructions. Service Vehicles will not be permitted to access the Stage or any closed road between runs. The organisers will, where possible, endeavour to remove any car to the nearest location where it can exit the stage. The transport of the car from that location is the responsibility of the competitor. The car must return by direct route to the Service Area.
- **10.1.4** Competitors availing of Rally 2 must present themselves at Service Out Control after 2, 4 or 5 stages, with their car, for re-scrutiny. Due time is 10 minutes before their original due time at that Control, and 15 Minutes maximum lateness will apply.
- **10.1.5** The R2C, once satisfied that the crew meets the conditions for a restart, will issue new time cards which will have a restart time and restart Control Number.

The restart position within the field shall be at the discretion of the COC/R2C.

**10.1.6** The organisers reserve the right to disallow restart on safety grounds or if the restart would interfere with the running of the rally.

#### 10.2 Penalties:

**10.2.1** Penalties will be applied as per Article 13.5, Appendix 29 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook (as published on MI Website).

#### 10.3 Award Eligibility:

- **10.3.1** In order to be classified as a finisher the crew must complete a minimum of 3 special stages, which must include the final stage and the finish control.
- **10.3.2** Crews completing the rally under Rally 2 regulations **will** be eligible to score points in Championships.
