1. Announcement

4.3 Entry Criteria:

In the event of an excess of 141 main field entries being received the following criteria will be applied to all entries received from the opening to the closing date of entries.

- 1. Dunlop Championship registered competitors as per Motorsport Ireland Appendix 31. Art 7.2.
- 2. Border championship Overall awards, 1st & 2nd in Class Drivers 2011 (Entries must be received by Priority closing date)
- 3. Mayo and District Motorsport club members who qualify under membership requirement sheet 2011. (Entry must be accompanied by details of assistance provided during 2011).
- 4. 10 entries allocated at the organisers discretion.
- 5. 10 entries allocated to competitors who have assisted with the running of stages events under Motorsport Ireland or Motorsport Association permit over the past 2 years.

All club members must supply the Chief Marshal with the names of at least 2 people one of whom will marshal or otherwise assist on the day and one who will assist with clean up on Monday 12th March 2012.

Notes:

- In all the above cases "Competitors" refers to drivers only.
- The driver must state on the entry form under which of the above criteria he/she wishes to be considered
- The onus will rest with the competitor to provide documentary proof of results stated.
- Any false declaration will result in the entry being refused.
- Qualifying under any of the above criteria does not guarantee an entry.
- The club reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning a reason.

5. Reconnaissance

5.1 Information:

Pace notes will be allowed on the event and competitors will be allowed to make pace notes on Saturday 10th March 2012 between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm. Recce stickers must be displayed on the top corner of the windscreen of the reconnaissance car.

Competitors must sign on before entering the stages at:

Location: Rally HQ. 2nd Floor, McWilliam Park Hotel, Claremorris. **Time:** Friday 9th March 2012 from 20.00 to 22.00.

Saturday 10th March 2012 from 8:30 to 12.00.

5.2 Pace note providers:

Pace notes will be available for sale by third parties. The club has no involvement in their preparation and accepts no responsibility or liability for their accuracy or otherwise.

5.3 Restrictions:

- Your attention is also drawn to Appendix 29, article 4 of Motorsport Ireland Yearbook referring to a competitor found on a stage outside the reconnaissance period.
- The Maximum Speed allowed on a stage during the reconnaissance is 60 kph unless a lower limit is indicated by a traffic sign or a written instruction issued by the organisers.
- Traversing the stage in the wrong direction is expressly forbidden.
- A maximum of three runs per stage are permitted, competitors will be signed in and out of each stage
- No commercial vans (e.g. Vito/Transit) are allowed to be used as reconnaissance vehicles.
- The special stages will be open to normal traffic therefore the safety and rights of other road users must be respected and due care must be shown to other traffic.
- The organisers will monitor the behavior of competitors on the reconnaissance route.

5.4 Penalties:

Reports of breaches of above regulations will be submitted to Motorsport Ireland who may convene a tribunal of inquiry.

6. Administrative Checks

Administrative checks:

- Documentation scrutiny is located at Rally Headquarters, McWilliam Park Hotel, Claremorris.
- Competition licences, I.R.D.S. or BRDS Letters of Acceptance and other documentation must be presented at documentation scrutiny.
- Top 20 crews & nominated crews must have Mechanical & Documentation Scrutiny completed BEFORE Ceremonial Start.

7. Scrutineering

- Mechanical Scrutiny will take place on Saturday 10th March 2012 between 14.00 19.00 at The Athletics Track, Balla Road, Claremorris.
- All competitors are required to have door decals on their car and have the first part of the Mechanical scrutiny sheet completed before they present the car for scrutineering.
- Logbooks are required for all cars.
- ALL CARS must be presented at Parc Ferme within 30 minutes of completing Mechanical Scrutineering.
- Driving of competing cars off the specified route to/from Scrutineering may lead to exclusion.
 After completing Mechanical scrutiny competitors are required to present themselves at documentation scrutiny. You are allowed 30 minutes to get from Mechanical scrutiny to documentation scrutiny.

8. Servicing

- There will be a designated fixed service area.
- Outside of the service area Support/Service is expressly forbidden (Art 11.5 Appendix 29 MI Yearbook).
- Judges of Fact will monitor the route.

9. Features of the Rally

9.1 Ceremonial Start:

A ceremonial Start will be held on 10th March 2012 in Claremorris Town Centre and is compulsory for top 20 competitors and competitors selected by the organising committee. Competitors required to attend the Ceremonial start will be notified with their Final Instructions and will be published on the Official Notice Board on Saturday 10th March 2012 at 8.00. Competitors participating in the Ceremonial start will have priority at Mechanical & Documentation Scrutiny.

Cars participating in the Ceremonial Start may be removed from Parc Ferme from 20.00 Saturday 10th March 2012. Crews must follow the route specified in the Roadbook (also included in the Rally Guide). There will be a Pre-Ceremonial start holding area, in which all cars are required to be present at 20:30. Competitors will proceed from the Pre-Ceremonial Start Holding Area to the Ceremonial Start under the instructions of the organisers.

On completing the Ceremonial start competitors will be issued with a departure time and allowed 15 minutes to return to Parc Ferme, penalties for lateness will apply, early arrival will not be penalised.

All crews are required to wear their rally suits.

9.2 Competitors Safety Briefing:

Competitors Safety Briefing will be held at 8.00 on Sunday 11th March 2012 in Rally Headquarters. It is compulsory for at least one member of the crew to attend. Appendix 25 Art 3.2.

9.3 Route Information:

The rally will take place over a route of 123 stage Km and 137 road Km and will comprise of 9 stages based on 3 stages repeated 3 times with centralized service after every 3 stages.

Please remember at all times:

ON ROAD SECTIONS THE ROADS ARE NOT CLOSED. THEY ARE BEING USED BY PUBLIC. BE COURTEOUS. GIVE WAY TO ONCOMING LOCAL TRAFFIC. DO NOT ALLOW YOUR DRIVING GIVE A BAD IMPRESSION. A "JUDGE OF FACT" MAY BE OBSERVING YOU.
