Event

This event takes place on private property in Coolgraney, Inch Co. Wexford. **By kind permission of the land owner.**

Take Junction 21, then take the R772 exit to/Arklow (South)/Inch. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto R772. Go through straight through next roundabout then turn right onto L1004 at Inch (At Campus Service Station). The event will be arrowed from Gorey and Inch. **GPS Co-ordinates: 52.74936708, -6.26096249.**

Competitors

Entries are open to all drivers whom hold a current license and log book, which must be produced at scrutiny.

Midget Racing Car -

Midget Car Racing as per M.R.C.C.I. regulations.

Entry Fee: €95, Juniors and Intermediates €50 and Midgets €90 (All include Competitors Personal Accident Insurance)
Entries to be received by Wednesday 28th August 2013.

Classes:

- 1: Sports Car & Saloons up to 1400cc with engine over driven wheels
- 2a: Saloons and Sports cars from 1401cc to 1650cc with engine over driven wheels
- 2b: All other Saloons and Sports cars to 1650cc.
- 3a: Saloons and Sports cars over 1650cc with engine over driven wheels
- 3b: All other saloons and sports cars not qualifying for classes 1, 2, or 3A.
- 4a: Specials, Single Seaters Sports racing cars all motorcycle engined cars including 4WD cars up to 2100cc
(Only open to competitors 18 years and over)
- 4b: Specials, Single Seaters and Sports racing cars including 4WD cars over 2100cc.
Motorcycle engines not allowed. (Only open to competitors 18 years and over)
- 5a: "Intermediate class" 16 to 18 year olds, holding a "Speed National B" license in Saloon Cars up to 1650cc.
- 5b: "Junior class" 14 to 16 year old, holding a "Junior" license in Saloon Cars up to 1400cc
- 6: Rallycar Class for cars which compete with rally regulations, unlimited engine capacity.
(Does not qualify for championship awards or points)
- 7: All Midget Cars

Scrutiny Requirements as per MI yearbook Appendix 2

- All vehicles must pass scrutiny
- All vehicles must be fitted with fire extinguishers of an approved type
- All vehicles must be fitted with a full roll cage
- All saloon cars must be fitted with FIA approved seats
- Fireproof clothing must be worn as per Motorsport Ireland regulations
- Overhead/ roof skid pans and side netting are compulsory on specials
- Seats, safety belts and helmets of an approved type must be used. See specification in current yearbook and latest MI bulletins

Timing:

- Timing will be to 1/100th of a second from a flying start to a flying finish.

Awards:

- 1st Overall Saloons and Specials
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd in Ladies class
- Best Novice

Winners of the overall award will not be eligible for class awards.
Additional awards may be presented.

Exclusion:

Competitors will be excluded from the results for the following offences.

- Failure to pass scrutiny.
- Failure to wear fireproof clothing (Balaclava, gloves, boots and socks), safety harness, crash helmet of the approved type while on the course.
- Failure to have the appropriate type of fire extinguisher in the car at all times during the event.
- Failure to obey a reasonable request from an official.
- Use of spikes, studs and chains are prohibited.

Penalties:

- 5 seconds for striking or passing on the wrong side of a standing red marker. In the case of a baulk only, penalties incurred in the first timed run will be carried forward to the re-run in all classes. Where red markers have been knocked down during a run and not replaced competitors are still required to follow the intended course, otherwise penalties as above will be applied. Red markers knocked after completion of a run will count. Four-wheel drive cars will incur a 5% penalty.

Protests:

- Protests will only be accepted as per MI regulations. No case for force majeure will be considered once a competitor has started the event.
