Competitors

Entries are open to all drivers whom hold a current competition license and log book, which must be produced at scrutiny.

Entry Fee: €100, Juniors and Intermediates €50 (All include Competitors Personal Accident Insurance)
Entries to be received by Wednesday 26th August 2015.

Classes:

Class 1: All Saloon cars up to 1450 c.c.

Class 2: All Saloon cars from 1451 c.c. to 1650 c.c. with not more than 2 valves per cylinder

Class 3: All Saloon cars from 1451 c.c. to 1650 c.c. with more than 2 valves per cylinder

Class 4: All Saloon cars from 1651 c.c. to 2100 c.c.

Class 5: All Saloon cars 2101 c.c. and over, 4WD cars and Turbocharged Saloon Cars

Class 6: Car Engined Specials.

Class 7: Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies

Class 8: Junior Class for 16 –18 year olds holding a Speed National B Licence in 2wd Saloon Cars up to 1650 cc

Scrutiny Requirements as per MI yearbook Appendix 2

- ≡ All vehicles must pass scrutiny
- ≡ All vehicles must be fitted with fire extinguishers of an approved type
- ≡ All vehicles must be fitted with a full roll cage
- ≡ All saloon cars must be fitted with FIA approved seats
- ≡ Fireproof clothing must be worn as per Motorsport Ireland regulations
- ≡ Overhead/ roof skid pans and side netting are compulsory on specials
- ≡ Seats, safety belts and helmets of an approved type must be used. See specification in current yearbook and latest MI bulletins

Timing:

- ≡ Timing will be to 1/100th of a second from a flying start to a flying finish.

Awards:

- ≡ 1st, 2nd and 3rd Overall
 - ≡ 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class
 - ≡ Best Lady
 - ≡ Best Club Member (not receiving an award)
- Winners of the overall award will not be eligible for class awards.
Additional awards may be presented.

Exclusion:

Competitors will be excluded from the results for the following offences.

- ≡ Failure to pass scrutiny.
- ≡ Failure to wear fireproof clothing (Balaclava, gloves, boots and socks), safety harness, crash helmet of the approved type while on the course.
- ≡ Failure to have the appropriate type of fire extinguisher in the car at all times during the event.
- ≡ Failure to obey a reasonable request from an official.
- ≡ Use of spikes, studs and chains are prohibited.

Penalties:

- ≡ 5 seconds for striking or passing on the wrong side of a standing red marker. In the case of a baulk only, penalties incurred in the first timed run will be carried forward to the re-run in all classes. Where red markers have been knocked down during a run and not replaced competitors are still required to follow the intended course, otherwise penalties as above will be applied. Red markers knocked after completion of a run will count.

Protests:

- ≡ Protests will only be accepted as per MI regulations. No case for force majeure will be considered once a competitor has started the event.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry or of my being permitted to take part in this event I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified the Carlow Car Club, Irish Automobile Club Ltd. t/a Royal Irish Automobile Club, Irish Motorsport Federation Ltd. t/a Motorsport Ireland and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s) (as the case may be) howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with this entry or my taking part in this event and notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents. Furthermore, in respect of any parts of this event on ground where Third Party Insurance is not required by law, this Agreement shall in addition to the parties named above extend to all and any other competitor(s) and their servants and agents and to all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s).
