11.30am SHARP (Check-in from 10.30 am). All drivers must hold a valid competition licence, which must be available for inspection at the start. **One day Licenses will be available on the day**.

PENALTIES: The time taken for each test will be the penalty for that test, with additional penalties as follows: each initial contact with a pylon: 5 seconds, each line fault: 5 seconds. The maximum loss (including failure) on any test will be the best correct performance in class plus 20 seconds.

NOTE THAT ALL LINES DURING A TEST MUST BE CROSSED BY A CAR'S LEADING WHEELS ONLY - i.e., STOP ASTRIDE ALL LINES. THERE IS A 5 SECOND PENALTY FOR PUTTING THREE OR FOUR WHEELS ACROSS A LINE.

<u>AWARDS</u>: Overall winner. 1st, 2nd in each of classes A-D, provided there are sufficient entries. Best Beginner overall. 1st Novice in each of classes A-D and Best Semi-Expert (Overall). No competitor may win more than one award. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes if necessary. Further awards may be given at the organisers' discretion.

TESTS IN ALL HEWISON CHAMPIONSHIP AUTOTESTS WILL BE MUCH MORE SUITABLE FOR ROAD-GOING AND MULTI VENUE CARS THAN IN PREVIOUS YEARS. THEY WILL BE SHORTER, EASIER TO LEARN AND REMEMBER, AND MORE OPEN SO THAT DRIVERS IN CLASS F WILL BE ABLE TO ENJOY THEMSELVES.
