1. The Event is an open Endurance Trial, promoted and organised by Co. Galway Motor Club Limited, hereinafter called the promoters. It will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland (MI), Appendix 35 MI Yearbook 2019, these supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued before the start of the event.
2. The Entry List opens on publication of these regulations and closes on Wednesday 4th September 2019

The Standard Entry fee is as follows: €230
(Less a deduction of €7 per person for those aged 16 / 17)

Entry Forms must be fully completed and accompanied by a cheque (**not post-dated**) made payable to **Galway Motor Club Ltd.** All cheques will be lodged on receipt.

Alternatively, you can make a bank transfer of **€230** to our account, (**Reference = DRIVERS NAME**) but you must submit the entry form **and proof of bank transfer** to be included as a valid entry.

3. **The maximum entry for the event is 70.**
Should the above not be reached the promoters reserve the right to cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary.
Turbo and four-wheel drive vehicles are ineligible.

4. Cars will start at 1 (one) minute intervals, except where directed otherwise by the organisers (some selectives may be at 30 second intervals).

5. Classes

The event will have seven classes as follows:

Class A1: Cars built to Endurance Specification up to 1000cc

Class A2: Cars built to Endurance Specification between 1001cc and 1400cc

Class B: Other Non Endurance Cars up to 1400 cc

Class C: Other Non Endurance Cars from 1401 to 2000 cc

Class D: Front Wheel Drive Retro type cars

Class E: Rear Wheel Drive Retro type cars

Class F: All Sports Cars*

*All MX5 roofs must be of a steel form, either bolted or stitch welded to the bodywork.

Tyres for Endurance Events:

- The Starmaxx Ice Gripper Tyre W810 and the Sunny Winter Grip SN 3860 are the Navigation Sub Committee Approved Control Tyres for the driven wheels in the Endurance Classes, A1 and A2 only.
- Tyres are free in all the other classes, as long as they comply with Appendix 35 21.14, (which prohibit the use of any tyre with an ‘open’ tread which might lead to damage to the private lanes used) or tyres marked ‘for competition use’ or anything similar. The Scrutineers decision on this will be final.

6. Awards

General Classification: 1st, 2nd, 3rd Overall (Combined From A1 & A2) - 2 Awards

Class Awards:

Class A1 – No sub divisions

Class A2 – Will be divided into: Master / Expert / Semi Expert / Novice /Beginner

Class B & C – No sub divisions

Class D /E /F – No sub divisions

The Overall winner will be decided from Class A1 and A2 (Endurance Class) competitors only.

Amalgamation of classes or additional awards may be announced at signing-on before the event.

Eligibility For Awards:

Those receiving awards for overall placing will not be eligible for class awards.

The organisers reserve the right to re-classify a competitor considered ineligible for a class, and/or amalgamate as required.

Classification will be based on the performance of the Driver and not the Navigator.

Master	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first three overall in an Endurance or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or winning any event, except a Navigation Rally, promoted under an MSA or MI Permit.
Expert	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first six overall in an Endurance or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or winning any event, except a Navigation Rally, promoted under an MSA or MI Permit
Semi Expert	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first fifteen overall in an Endurance or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, promoted under an MSA or MI Permit
Novice	This class qualification is: No class wins in an Endurance or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or any event promoted under an MSA or MI Permit
Beginner	First year of Endurance Trials or Targa Rallies

7. General Route

Organisers will use 1:50,000 maps when they are setting out the route card, but it is not envisaged that competitors will need maps, as a route book will be provided.

Penalties

Penalties as per Appendix 35 of the 2019 Motorsport Ireland Yearbook.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry or of my being permitted to take part in this event I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified the Co. Galway Motor Club Limited (Organising Club), Irish Automobile Club Ltd. t/a Royal Irish Automobile Club, Irish Motorsport Federation Ltd. t/a Motorsport Ireland and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s) (as the case may be) howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with this entry or my taking part in this event and notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents.
