HISTORIC RALLY OF THE LAKES 2013

The Historic Rally of the Lakes 2013, the fourth round of the FIA European Historic Rally Championship, takes place on the Bank Holiday weekend of May 3rd -5th in Killarney in the southwest of Ireland. Renowned for the beauty of its surrounding lakes and mountains and its many hotels, bars and restaurants Killarney has been welcoming visitors since 1850 and is regarded as the tourist capital of Ireland.

Killarney also has a long association with motor sport being one of the main stops on the 1901 Tour of Ireland and also the host town, in 1903, for the first ever hill climb run in Ireland (Won by the Hon Charles Rolls, co-founder of the Rolls Royce Motor Company) From 1932 until 1980 it was the southern base for the Circuit of Ireland International Rally. The stages around Killarney became justly renowned as some of the finest tarmac stages in Western Europe and formed the real competitive core of the Circuit of Ireland.

Since 1979 Killarney has been the base for the International Rally of the Lakes and each year these same classic tarmac stages make up the route of the two day event. Killarney is situated 88 km from Cork which has an international Airport and direct ferry service to Roscoff. Rosslare, which is 265 km from Killarney has direct ferry services to both UK and mainland Europe (Cherbourg), while Dublin, 303 km from Killarney, has an international airport and ferry services to UK and the Isle of Man. Kerry Airport which has daily flights to Dublin and UK is just 17km from Killarney.

Ireland's road network has seen substantial upgrading work in the past ten years so that all points of entry to the country are now within comfortable driving distance to Killarney

The 2013 Historic Rally of the Lakes will be run over 2 days, Saturday and Sunday with 8 stages on Saturday and seven on Sunday. Each leg will start with the most famous tarmac stage in Ireland, the 19km Molls Gap. Approximately 200km of competitive motoring, on closed roads, will be incorporated in an overall route of 450km. Service location will be centralised on both days.

The use of Pace Notes is permitted and the making and checking of notes will be



permitted on the previous weekend or on the Thursday and Friday immediately before the rally. Professionally made notes will be available form a number of suppliers but competitors are also free to make their own notes. A limited number of experienced Irish codrivers generally contact the organisers offering their services to visiting drivers. Competitors who wish to talk to these codrivers should contact the organisers who will provide the initial contact details.


