SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1. An Autotest and a Production Car Autotest is being organised by Classic Autotest Motorclub Ltd to be held on Saturday 20th January 2018 at Tony Patterson's, 49 Ballynahinch Rd, Saintfield, Ballynahinch BT24 7ND
- 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) these Supplementary Regulations and any other written instructions that the club may issue.
 - 3. The event is open to all fully elected members of Classic Autotest Motorclub Ltd, Autotest Drivers Club, Ballynahinch Motor Club, MG Car Club, M.I.N.I., Police Motor Club and Thoroughbred Sports Club.
 - 4 All competitors and passengers must produce a valid membership card.

Signing on and scrutineering at 8.30am
Drivers briefing at 9.45am
First car starts at 10am

- 5. The event will consist of the following classes:-
 - CLASS 1: All FWD cars under 11ft 8"
 - CLASS 2: All FWD cars over 11ft 8"
 - CLASS 3: All RWD cars under 1500 cc
 - CLASS 4: All RWD cars over 1500 cc
 - **CLASS 5: Production Car**
 - **CLASS 6: Autotest Specials**
- 6. The maximum entry is 45 and the minimum is 10. If any class is not achieved, the organizers reserve the right to amalgamate classes. The organisers have the right to cancel the event, refuse an entry or re-classify an entrant.
- 7. All production cars should be standard (all four seats fitted). Passenger in production car must be 12 years of age or over if driver has full RTA license. If driver has not a full licence passenger must have full RTA license and be experienced in autotesting. The vehicle must by definition a touring car.
- 8. Tyres must be road legal.
- 9. Juniors Car must be standard (all four seats fitted) and must not exceed 1400cc. One passenger only holding a full RTA licence will be allowed during any test.
- 10. Only passengers signed on will be allowed in the car during the test and anyone found to have changed passenger will forfeit points and be excluded from results. Passenger must wear a properly fastened seatbelt at all times. Windows to be kept up during tests. NO HIRED CARS ALLOWED.
- 11. Competitors are also reminded that car must be scrutineered before signing on.
- 12. Competitors are also reminded of noise limits as per MSA Regulations J5.17.1-8.

- 13. Details of tests will be issued at signing-on. **PRACTISING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AND MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION**.
- 14. Timing will be by hand held stopwatch to the nearest 0.10 second. The starting signal will be verbal and where possible the order of attempting tests should be numerical.
- 15. Penalties will be as follows as per MSA Yearbook Table M.7:-
 - A. Striking pylons/cones 5 seconds.
 - B. Line Fault 5 seconds.
 - C. Not performing a test correctly FAIL (fastest time in class + 20 seconds).
 - D. Passenger assisting junior by pulling on handbrake 10 seconds
- 16. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that their name, car and class all appear on their timecard and that it is kept legible and in fair condition.
- 17. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event, and a copy will be posted on club website and facebook.
- 18. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with MSA Regulation C.5.1 5.7.
- 19. Entries must be made on official entry form accompanied by the appropriate fee of £20.00 and £15 for juniors or if paying by PayPal £21 and £16 for juniors.
